

Children's Summer Treatment Program

Award winning program providing state-of-the-art treatment for Children with ADHD and Behavioral Disorders



Over the course of this 6-week camp, your child will learn effective ways to manage ADHD and conduct problems! This program provides treatment tailored to each child's behavioral, emotional, and learning difficulties in the context of a fun, day camp.

The Summer Treatment Program (STP) accepts children between the ages of 6 and 12.

Children will be placed into two groups of 12, taught by specialists and supervised by a clinical psychologist. Each group spends two hours each day in sessions conducted by developmental specialists. These specialists carry out behavior modification programs designed to treat children's problems in a group and in a classroom context. Children will learn to control their behavior through praise, positive reinforcement, and reward systems. Individualized and computer-assisted instruction is also provided.

Children will participate in sports and outside activities, to fully enjoy the summer! There will many enjoyable activities to make the days fly by!

- ✦ **The Summer Treatment Program costs \$3800.**
- ✦ **The program begins on Monday, July 14th, 2008 and will end on Friday, August 22nd. The STP runs Monday - Friday, 8am - 4pm.**
